2011 Benin Mission Trip

Purpose

Short-term trips are designed to be an active part of a developed Christian community vision that supports the work which continues throughout the year.

Location: Benin, West Africa located near Ghana and Nigeria.

Weather: Tropical-rainy with temps in mid 70s (just like South Florida) **Currency:** CFA Francs 450=\$1

Transportation: Air France **Trip Cost:** \$4,985 USD per person to cover air, lodging, ground transportation, and select meals.

What to Bring: Passport with Benin Visa.

Clothes: pack light materials with long-sleeves, hat, toiletries, sunglasses, hand wipes, hand sanitizer, body cleaning wipes, insect repellent with DEET. Prescription meds should be in carry-on properly labeled with a list from doctor.

Visa & Vaccination deadline- June 3, 2011

Friday, May 20th- No Penalty

Monday, May 30th- 50% Penalty
